## **Committee Meetings Summary**

The club committee met on 6/5/09 and 11/5/09. The following is a summary of the meetings.

**Chief Coaches** – Martin Nichols was welcomed to the committee – he has been appointed Chief Coach for paragliding. Chris Jones will continue as Chief Coach for hang gliding.

**Cloudbase Paragliding** – A new paragliding school, Cloudbase Paragliding, has asked to use certain of the club's sites for training. The club has given permission for Cloudbase to use Selsley for training students in the final stages of their CP training, although the agreement is yet to be signed.

**Sites guide for Westbury** – The sites guide for Westbury is to be updated.

Club sites and visiting pilots The committee would like to remind pilots that visiting pilots are welcome on our sites, but they must be fully conversant with the site rules and must have up-to-date membership of the BHPA (or international equivalent). In the case of Draycott, pilots must be members of the Avon club.
